

## SHORT BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

### **PIOTR S. WANDYCZ**

born September 20, 1923 in Krakow, Poland. Went to school in Poland and France. During World War II served as 2nd lieut. in Polish Army in Great Britain. Studied history at universities of Grenoble ,Cambridge (B.A.,1948, MA.1952 ) and London School of Economics ( Ph.D, 1951) . In the United States since 1951.

Taught East Central European history at Indiana University , Columbia University-- as visiting professor -- Central European University in Budapest , and Yale University from 1966 to 1997. Currently Bradford Durfee Professor Emeritus of History.

Author of 17 books (two of which received G. L. Beer Prize and W. Vucinich Prize, and a third --- *The Price of Freedom : A History of East Central Europe* --was translated into 8 languages) and over 400 articles and reviews in English, French, Polish, Czech, Italian, German , Recipient of among others Hlavka Medal of Ceskoslovenska Akademia Ved, Decorated with Commander's Cross of Polonia Restituta . President of Polish Institute of Arts and Sciences of America (1999- ). Elected to the Polish Academy of Sciences ( PAN) and the Academy of Arts and Sciences ( PAU) ; honorary member of Polish Historical Association (PTH). Doctor honoris causa of Wrocław University, Université Paris 1 - Sorbonne , Jagiellonian University , Lublin Catholic University. Listed in current *Who's Who in America* and others biographical dictionaries.
