

Ten Ta To

A unique Czech language training application for Android and iOS phones.

Ten-Ta-To is a nonprofit project to create a **new tool for training and remembering Czech grammatical genders**. Their correct identification is very important for proper use of the Czech language. For many students, and even for some second generation Czechs, it is often a frustrating exercise.

No internet connection necessary.

Free to download from Google Play and App Store.

Ten-Ta-To application will contain **4,000 of the most frequently used nouns**, including nouns from the popular textbook *New Czech Step by Step*. The adjective **dobrý, dobrá, dobré** (good) will appear with the correct answer to help the memorization process. The application will have the following functions:

1. A **summary of rules** and guidelines to determine the gender of Czech nouns.
2. A **look-up** of a noun's gender by typing the first few letters of the word.
3. **Activities** for practicing and memorizing the correct gender.

A user can...

- **play** a three-level game of selecting the gender of random words; incorrectly answered words are cycled back until the correct answer is given (SRS). Student will see statistics of her/his progress;
- **create** a personal list of problematic words;
- **look up** the definition and usage of a word by clicking the word and accessing a dictionary.

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
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

Ten, ta, to are demonstrative pronouns *this/that* used for indicating masculine, feminine or neuter gender of Czech nouns.

Czech natives apply the correct gender intuitively. But for English speakers it is a challenge. Often, the Czech gender is not natural or logical, for example **kostel - postel, kůl - sůl**.

However, it is very important to identify the proper gender for further correct use of Czech nouns, adjectives, pronouns, numbers and the past tense participle, as in other Slavic languages.
